AND NOW, we find that the Swatara Township Zoning Hearing Board did not commit an error of law or abuse its discretion in denying Appellant's application.

For the foregoing reasons, we enter the following Order:

ORDER

AND NOW, this 15th day of January, 2020, upon consideration of the Land Use Appeal that was filed by Appellant Scott A. Mancini and any responses filed thereto, and having heard oral argument on December 12, 2019, it is hereby ORDERED, for the reasons set forth in the attached Memorandum Opinion, that Appellant's Appeal is DENIED. It is further ORDERED that the decision of the Swatara Township Zoning Hearing Board with respect to Appellant is AFFIRMED.

Crimes and Criminal Procedure - Search and Seizure - Consent Search - Scope

Defendant sought to suppress crack cocaine seized from his groin area pursuant to a consent search of his person which was conducted in a public parking lot.

- 1. An objective reasonableness standard is used to determine the scope of a consent search: "what would the typical reasonable person have understood by the exchange between the officer and the suspects? *Florida v. Jimeno*, 111 S.Ct. 1801, 1803-04 (1991). The scope of the search is limited by the terms of its authorization, and if the government does not honor those limitations of the consent search, the search is impermissible. *Reedy v. Evanson*, 615 F.3d 197, 225 (3rd Cir. 2010). The government bears the burden to prove that the search was conducted within the scope of that consent. *United States v. Strickland*, 902 F.2d 937, 941 (11th Cir. 1990).
- 2. Under normal circumstances, a consent to a search of one's person does not extend to one's private regions. U.S. v. Blake, 888 F.2d 795 (11th Cir. 1989). There is a heightened expectation of privacy to one's person than there is to one's vehicle; however, there is an even higher expectation of privacy in one's private parts.

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Presently before this Court is a pretrial Motion to Suppress Evidence filed by Defendant Sylvester Anderson (hereinafter "Defendant"). A suppression hearing was held on January 23, 2020 and both parties submitted proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. Therefore, this matter is now ripe for decision.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The testimony from the Preliminary Hearing and Suppression Hearing revealed the following facts: Officer Chad McGowan (hereinafter "Officer McGowan") of the City of Harrisburg Police Department was on duty in July 2017. (Notes of Testimony, Preliminary Hearing, 8/1/10 ("N.T.") at 3.) Officer McGowan was accompanied by Adult Probation Officer Chianos, Sheriff Deputy Long, Sheriff Deputy Maurice Edwards, and Corporal Jeffrey Teeter, all of whom were in an unmarked police car as part of their patrol for the Street Crimes Unit. (N.T. at 3-4). Around 11:35 P.M., Officer McGowan encountered Defendant in the parking lot of Harrisburg Fried Chicken on Market Street. (N.T. at 3). This parking lot is known to officers as a "high crime, high drug area." (N.T. at 4).

Officer McGowan observed that the Defendant was "crawling around or doing something to the driver's side of a red Dodge Ram pickup truck." (N.T. at 4). Officer McGowan pulled the car up beside the defendant, saw he was "profusely sweating," and asked if the Defendant was okay. (Id.) The Defendant responded in the affirmative and stated that he had "dropped something on the ground." (N.T. at 4-5).

Defendant then entered Harrisburg Fried Chicken. (N.T. at 5). Officer McGowan noticed that the driver's side window of the truck was down, which he believed was uncommon for this area. (Id.) In addition, the car was not parked within the lines of the parking lot. (Id.) Officer McGowan "became suspicious that maybe the male ... was intoxicated maybe under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance." (Id.) Officer McGowan testified that loss of "motor skills" or forgetting to do something could be a side effect of consuming alcohol or a controlled substance. (N.T. at 5, 14).

When Defendant exited Harrisburg Fried Chicken, he noticed the officers were still present in the parking lot, and then "began to walk the opposite direction" away from the officers and the truck. (N.T. at 6.) Officer McGowan approached Defendant and asked for permission to speak to him. (Id.) Defendant granted consent. (Id.) Officer McGowan asked for identification, and the Defendant provided a valid identification. (Id.) Officer McGowan asked if the Defendant was on parole, and the Defendant replied that he was. (Id.)

Officer McGowan then asked if the Defendant had "anything illegal on his person," to which the Defendant answered in the negative. (N.T. at 6-7.) He then asked Defendant for permission to search his person, and the Defendant granted consent. (N.T. at 7). The Defendant "[held] his arms in the air (indicated), like, Go ahead and search me, after he had already given me [Officer McGowan] verbal consent." (Id.)

Officer McGowan then "sweeped [sic] over [Defendant's] groin area...and [he] could feel a distinct hard bulge; and it was immediately apparent to [him] that [Defendant] had a large amount of crack down his pants." (N.T. 7). Defendant attempted to flee, but was tackled and detained rather quickly. (N.T. at 8). It was later determined that the substance was indeed crack cocaine. (N.T. at 9).

Officer McGowan testified that he has seven years of experience with investigating drug related crimes, and it was this prior experience that led him to believe the object found in the defendant's pants was crack cocaine. (N.T. at 7, 8-9). He stated that it is relatively commonplace for people to "conceal, store, try and hide narcotics down their pants in an effort to hide them" from officers. (N.T. at 7).

DISCUSSION

We find Officer McGowan's testimony to be credible, and find that consent was freely given, and that Officer McGowan immediately recognized the object found in Defendant's pants as contraband. The remaining question before this court is whether Officer McGowan exceeded the consent Defendant granted him. Since this appears to be a novel issue in Pennsylvania, we must look to Federal cases for guidance.

An objective reasonableness standard is used to determine the scope of a consent search: "what would the typical reasonable person have understood by the exchange between the officer and the suspect?" Florida v. Jimeno, 111 S.Ct. 1801, 1803-04 (1991). The "scope of the search is limited by the terms of its authorization," and if the government does not honor those limitations of the consent search, the "search is impermissible." Reedy v. Evanson, 615 F.3d 197, 225 (3rd Cir. 2010); United States v. Strickland, 902 F.2d 937, 941 (11th Cir. 1990). The government bears the burden to prove that the search was conducted within the scope of that consent. Strickland, 902 F.2d at 941.

A United States Court of Appeals has held, under normal circumstances, that a consent to a search of one's person does not extend to one's private regions. <u>U.S. v. Blake</u>, 888 F.2d 795 (11th Cir. 1989). In <u>Blake</u>, officers, dressed in plainclothes, approached the defendants and asked permission to speak to them. The defendants both consented, and handed over the plane tickets and identification at the request of the officers. The documents were returned to the defendants, and the officers asked for consent to search their

bags and persons. The officers informed the defendants of their right to refuse, but both defendants consented to the search. Blake, 888 F.2d at 797.

Within seconds of Blake's having given his consent, Hendrick [one of the officers] reached into Blake's groin region where he did a 'frontal touching' of the 'outside of [Blake's] trousers' in 'the area between the legs where the penis would normally be positioned.' Upon reaching into Blake's crotch, Hendrick felt an object and heard a crinkling sound.

Eason, the co-defendant, endured the same treatment. Id.

The Court stated that the defendants' grant of consent could not "be construed as authorization for the officers to touch their genitals in the middle of a public area in the Fort Lauderdale Airport." Blake, 888 F.2d at 800. It was not reasonable for the officers to believe that the consent to search the persons meant they had consent to search the defendants' genital region, especially in a public area; more explanation from the officers as to the scope of the search would have been necessary. The court did the leave the door for "intrusive" consent searches to be permissible, but the officer must "obtain proper consent" to do so.

This court questions whether a reasonable person would believe that a general consent to search their person would include a search of their private regions, especially when such an encounter with police is being conducted in public. The Commonwealth argues that a reasonable person would understand that a search of the person would include a search of private places because that is where contraband can be hidden, and cites to Florida v. Jimeno, 111 S.Ct. 1801 (1991) as authority. However, there is a heightened expectation of privacy to one's person than there is to one's vehicle; moreover, there is an even higher expectation of privacy in one's private parts.

The Commonwealth also argues that the Defendant did not "restrict the scope of his consent to a search of his person for contraband." (Commonwealth's Proposed Findings of Fact, page 8.) However, there was nothing in the verbal exchange between the officer and the Defendant as to what the officer was looking for, or where the officer intended to search. Without the officer stating how thorough a search was intended, or what the search was for, there would be no reason to state that his consent did not extend to his genitals. If anything, a reasonable person would most likely expect a <u>Terry</u> pat-down weapons search, as routinely seen in movies and television. This Court would conclude that even a Transportation Security Administration ("TSA") search would not include the genital area without specific consent or moving the search to a non-public location.

Although this Court is impressed with Officer McGowan's police instincts, we are constrained to conclude that the search of Defendant's person exceeded the scope of consent that Defendant granted.

Officer McGowan searched Defendant's groin region in a public parking lot, and it was not reasonable for Officer McGowan to believe that the Defendant's consent extended to such an intrusive search of a private area. Accordingly, the Commonwealth was unable to meet its burden of proving valid consent to conduct such an invasive search of the intimate parts of his person.

Accordingly, we enter the following Order:

ORDER

AND NOW, this 20th day of April, 2020, following a suppression hearing held on January 23, 2020, and having reviewed the case law and briefs submitted by counsel, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Defendant's Motion to Suppress is **GRANTED** and all evidence following the improper search of Defendant's person shall be **SUPPRESSED**.
